



# **Parcel Map**





#### Site Plan









Currently, 50.5% of the 89,855 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 44.7%, renter occupied; and 4.8% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.0% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.4% are renter occupied; and 11.6% are vacant. In 2010, there were 88,260 housing units in the area – 52.2% owner occupied, 29% renter occupied, and 4.9% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 0.80%. Median home value in the area is \$31.94.60, compared to a median home value of \$190,791 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 4.35% annually to \$395,195.
